



Investigator-Sponsored Study (ISS) Eligibility guidelines

What can and cannot be supported?

- ⇒ Support may be awarded only to approved requests that fall within our corporate therapeutic areas and that meet our research objectives. Research support requests must also comply with Solvay company policies and guidelines, which reflect the FDA Code of Federal Regulations, the Office of the Inspector General Guidance, and the PhRMA Code on Interactions with Healthcare Professionals.
- ⇒ Support will not be awarded to research that does not meet Solvay safety guidelines or that is duplicative of other investigator-sponsored or company-sponsored studies.

Who can receive research support?

- ⇒ Research support will only be provided to qualified investigators who can meet FDA standards to conduct quality research.

Budget Guidelines

- ⇒ All applications requesting monetary support will require the submission of a detailed proposed budget for the cost of the entire program, including overhead and/or indirect costs.
- ⇒ If monetary support is awarded, Solvay will require access to an accounting of how the funds were spent.

Application Requirements

- ⇒ Information submitted by the applicant will include Principal Investigator's Curriculum Vitae, project summary, full protocol, budget (if applicable) and a W-9.
- ⇒ All documents submitted by the applicant must be dated and have a version number.
